His Life Motto is two words, "FOLLOW GOD"

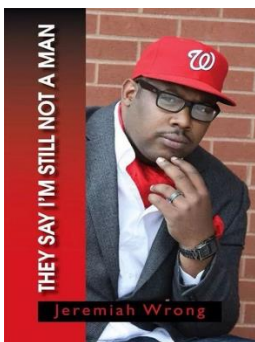


Kent Ostrander 66, Married GLM Advisory
